

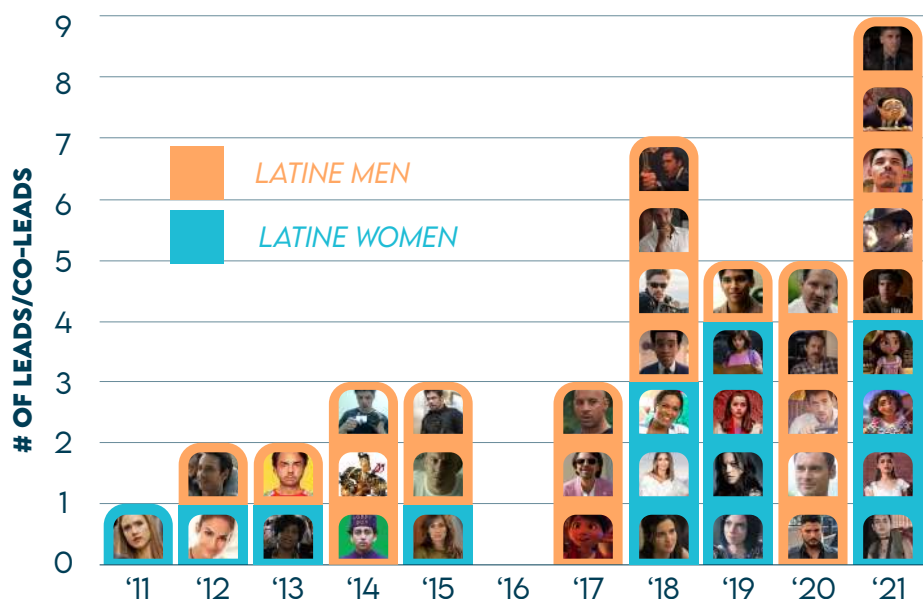
LATINE WOMEN IN MEDIA



FACTS

- Latine women are 8.2% of the US population, but represent only 1.9% of all leads/co-leads in popular films (Annenberg Inclusion Initiative, 2021).
- Of the top grossing films of 2019, 59% had no Latine women characters (Annenberg Inclusion Initiative, 2021).
- Only 2.4% of characters in television shows are Latine women (Nielsen, 2020).
- Fewer than 1% of the top films of the past decade were directed by Latine women (Annenberg Inclusion Initiative, 2021).
- When they do appear in film and TV, Latine women are often stereotyped as maids, as impoverished, and as short-tempered. They are often depicted as the "Spicy Latina" trope (TTIE, 2020).
