Position Overview

The Gender Justice Curriculum Facilitator will teach The Representation Project's gender justice curriculum in local high schools in Los Angeles. This part-time role involves facilitating eight modules that cover media literacy, challenging harmful gender norms, mental health, healthy relationships, sex education, and advocacy for gender justice.

Primary Responsibilities

Curriculum Facilitation:

- Deliver engaging and interactive workshops focused on topics related to gender justice to high school students in Los Angeles.
- Foster safe and inclusive environments for open discussions.
- Utilize creative teaching methods to ensure student engagement and comprehension of the curriculum content.

Student Engagement:

- Cultivate a respectful and supportive atmosphere that encourages students to share their thoughts and experiences.
- Facilitate group activities, projects, and discussions that promote critical thinking and self-expression.
- Provide guidance and mentorship to help students explore and understand complex gender justice issues.

Collaboration:

- Collaborate with high school students, staff, teachers, and administrators to coordinate session schedules and logistics.
- Work closely with The Representation Project team to provide feedback on curriculum effectiveness and student engagement.



Assessment and Reporting:

- Assess students' understanding and progress through pre- and post surveys.
- Provide regular reports and feedback to the Director of Youth Programs on curriculum delivery, student participation, successes, and challenges.

Required Attributes, Skills, and Experience

- A strong commitment to challenging intersectional gender stereotypes and norms.
- A deep understanding of how gender, race, class, age, sexual orientation, and body size intersect.
- Passion for working with youth and creating positive learning environments.
- Excellent communication skills, both written and verbal, to effectively engage and facilitate workshops with diverse groups of students.
- Strong organizational skills to manage curriculum materials, session schedules, and reporting.
