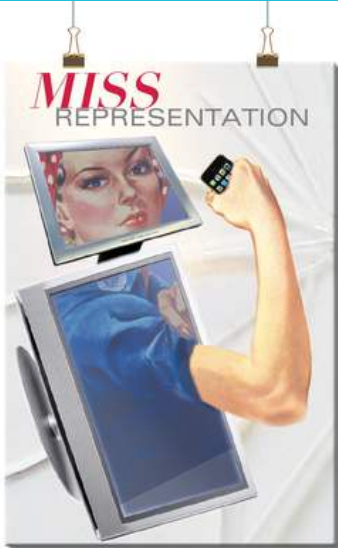

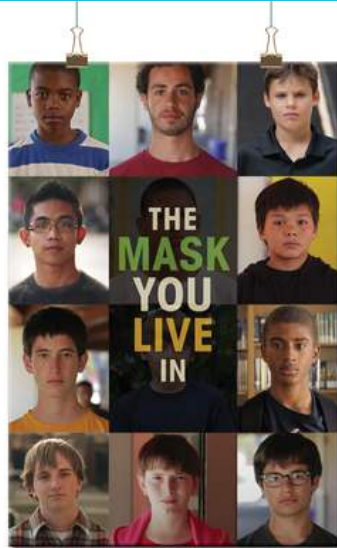
## MISS REPRESENTATION

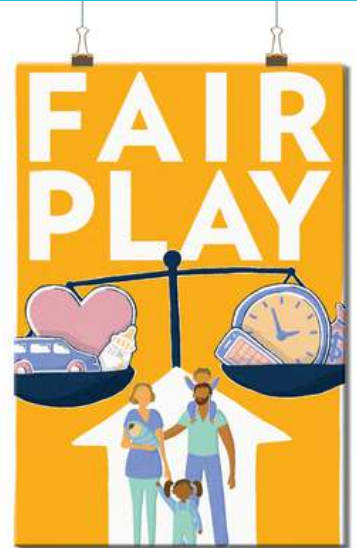
## THE GREAT AMERICAN LIE
